

## Decoy Committee Meeting Notes

Present at the meeting: Sean, Jake, OJ, Andrew

Date and Time: 06-06-2013 Start: 8:30pm PDT End: 10:50pm PDT

1. Todd Dunlap: The committee decided that Todd will need to re-take the decoy certification (physical and written). His Cert. expires on June 27th 2013. Jake motioned, Andrew second and the motion was passed.
2. Scott Dunsmore: The committee decided that Scott will need to take the written test only to show that he still knows the rules. After he passes the test he will be put back on the active decoy list. Sean volunteered to give him the test. The test will be recorded. Scott re-certified on Oct. 21st 2012. Jake Motioned, Sean seconded, and the motion was passed.
3. We discussed creating a suitable test for the level 3 (Sean has agreed to let the members view a video of the Super Selection were he got his lvl 3.
4. Super Selection for Nationals?: We decided to table that discussion until we get more info on it and more decoy interest in doing the Nationals.
5. The committee would like to make decoys submit a copy of their decoy book that would show the trials they have done the prior year. We would like to put a deadline on getting the info to the committee January 15th. We wanted to make it the same time that your membership would be due to make it simple for the decoys to do. We also would like them to update their info at the same time. If decoys fail to do this they will be put on the inactive list.
6. The committee would also like to remind ALL decoys that they need to sign score sheets and books at every trial they do. This is a new rule and we don't think that decoys are remembering to do it.
7. The committee also talked about doing certifications in the near future. Each member will look over the cert. score sheet and come up with a new way of doing it. We will email each other with our ideas and meet in 3-5 weeks to hammer out a new cert.
8. The Decoy Committee would also like some input on decoys being assigned to trials.
9. The committee also decided that decoys that have been put on the inactive list must take a written test and pay membership in order to be put back on the active decoy list. The committee will take each decoy on a case by case basis and additional items might be required.
10. We would also like the boards input on the conflict of interest.
